Sometimes parents/caregivers have worries:

- “I am worried about my child’s development they seem to be behind their peers.”
- “When my child speaks others have difficulty understanding what they are saying.”
- “My child doesn’t want to attend Kinder - when I leave they are upset”
- “My child chooses to play alone and doesn’t talk about their friends at Kinder”
- “My child will hurt others when they are upset or anxious”
- “My child won’t sit still to complete activities.”



The Preschool Field Officer program supports the access and meaningful participation of all children in state funded Kindergartens.

With your consent the PSFO's can obtain information to inform them on how to best support your child in their learning environment. This can be achieved through:

- Speaking with you about your child.
- Observing your child within the Kindergarten setting.

The PSFO supports children's transition into Kindergarten, throughout the Kinder year and transition to school.
